

Enhancing Digital Photography with Photoshop CS2

Photoshop CS2 is the parent software of Photoshop Elements. This is the software used by graphic designers. It allows the user to work in CMYK and spot color—unlike Photoshop Elements which only allows for RGB when it comes to color. (Great for web work but not usable for files going to a printing company)

We will go through the steps it takes to size, color, sharpen and retouch digital photos. In addition, we will get creative with layers and feathering tools.
